RESOLUTION NO. 2158

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, MONTANA AMENDING THE LANDFILL FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, the City Council (hereinafter "Council") of the City of Hardin. Montana (hereinafter "City") operates a landfill in Big Horn County, Montana;

WHEREAS, the Council, pursuant to Section 8-1-21 of the Hardin City Code is authorized to establish fees to be charged for dumping by commercial contractors and non-City residents, and dumping by City residents; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the best interest of City to amend the fee schedule to accept clean fill dirt at a reduced rate because of the benefit to City landfill.

NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, MONTANA:

City may accept clean fill dirt, acceptable to use as cover or daily cover, at City's discretion, determined by the director of the City landfill, the Director of Public Works, or the Mayor.

Clean fill dirt must be free of all contaminants including, but not limited to. petroleum products and heavy metals, and is subject to testing, at the cost of the dumping party, upon City request. City may request inspection of the source of clean fill dirt to determine if City will accept the dirt into the landfill.

Clean fill dirt includes sediment collected from headworks of wastewater treatment facilities, or similar and acceptable sources from wastewater treatment facilities not owned and used by City. The Director of Public Works or Mayor has the discretion to accept or reject such fill from wastewater treatment facilities.

City will assess a dumping fee of \$15.00 (fifteen dollars) per ton for clean fill dirt at City landfill.
